

Sal can mark the day when her life changed forever - the day she joined Grameen Australia's Chicken Training Centre. She was young but determined to escape the pain and poverty of her home life. Sal is now a senior graduate managing our chick pen and a small team of trainee farmers.

Following 4 years of hard work from our committed trainee farmers, all former scavengers from the local dumpsite, our Chicken Training Centre in Siem Reap is close to breaking even.

Breaking even means we can scale our social impact even further by developing a new Village Rearing Cooperative Program for families to establish their own chicken rearing business. Families will be supported with training, mentoring and microfinance and guaranteed fair sale price for their chickens.
