Last year many of you supported us to buy a plot of land in Siem Reap for our Village Grower Project. We are pleased to say.... **HERE IT IS!**



The full payment of \$103,160 has been used on the project. The land is ours and we are cleared to build the second chicken farm.

Your input to the crowdfunding campaign made ALL of this possible. Congratulations and thank you!

Now that we own the land, the next step is to build infrastructure so that we can provide disease-free, healthy eggs to our Village Grower Farmers.

In the next month we need to build:

- o) 2 sheds for the chickens who lay eggs
- o) 1 shed for growing newly hatched chicks

We also need to set up electricity and build a new well with properly chlorinated drinking water.

Our goal is to use microfinance and social business to build a socially and economically inclusive 'World of Three Zeroes' where all humans lead dignified, meaningful lives



Our pilot grower farm is up and running, and is owned by the very proud husband and wife Mr Chor and Ms Salat
